APACHE CHRISTIAN TRAINING SCHOOL (ACTS)

This program provides theological courses to train people of the San Carlos and White Mountain Apache reservations, emphasizing hands-on experience. Students come from backgrounds as teachers, biologists, loggers, sawmill workers, and tribal administrators. Upon completion of courses, students are eligible for calls as pastors, Bible teachers, deacons or deaconesses, evangelists, and church musicians.
